The Prophet (\*) said, "Faith (Belief) consists of more than sixty branches (i.e. parts). And Haya (modesty/shyness, etc.) is a part of faith."

Righteousness is not that you turn your faces toward the east or the west, but [true] righteousness is [in] one who believes in Allāh, the Last Day, the angels, the Book, and the prophets and gives wealth, in spite of love for it, to relatives, orphans, the needy, the traveler, those who ask [for help], and for freeing slaves; [and who] establishes prayer and gives zakāh; [those who] fulfill their promise when they promise; and [those who] are patient in poverty and hardship and during battle. Those are the ones who have been true, and it is those who are the righteous.

Abu Dharr (radiyAllaahu`anhu) asked the Prophet (\*) about eemaan, and he recited this verse

## Muslim's narration:

- The highest/greatest branch is 'laa ilaaha illAllaah
- Smallest is removing an obstacle from the road
- Shyness/modesty is a branch of faith

Numerous branches/components

- Heart
- Tongue
- Actions of the limbs

Of varyling levels/importance

Laa ilaaha illAllaah – greatest branch/component

'Qawl' – heart and tongue

Smallest – moving an obstacle from the road/pathway. Importance of actions and helping people. Still part of eemaan.

Hadith in Muslim – man who did this entered Paradise

Actions of the heart – e.g. hayaa (modestly/shyness)

Hugely important. Big impact.

Hadith:

"Indeed from the earliest prophecies which the people received was: 'If you feel no shame then do as you wish"

[N40 – hadith 20]

Absence of 'hayaa' (modesty/shyness) -> people do all sorts of despicable things and won't be bothered about it.

## Hadiths:

"Hayaa consists of nothing but good"

"Hayaa brings about only good (i.e. it is good in every sense)"

Enemies of Islam – this is the first thing they work against (E.g. toys and clothing).

Modesty of the Prophet (\*). Cf nowadays.

Great need for this in this day and age. (E.g. the West).

Hayaa from Allaah:

(?)

- He sees you;
- He has given you all these blessings etc.
- How could you disobey Him?

60 or 70 odd – but types of good deed so numerous (?)

- Categories (e.g. ihsan...)
- Just means a lot....
- Most important examples of aspects of eemaan
